## **Operating Instructions**

Before using your soldering iron please ensure that the tip is properly positioned and secured by it retaining screw.

Soldering tips must only be removed from there holder when cool and the retaining screw has been loosened.

Always place the soldering iron on it holder to avoid burns to users & property, and for general safety reasons.

This equipment is intended for use with soft solder only.


## IMPORTANT

This appliance must be earthed. The wires in the mains lead are coloured in accordance with the following code:

Blue - Neutral Brown - Live Green and Yellow - Earth As the colours of the wires in the mains lead of this appliance may not correspond with the Coloured markings identifying the terminals in your plug, proceed as follows:

The wire which is coloured blue must be connected to the terminal which is marked with  $\ensuremath{\textbf{N}}.$ 

The wire which is coloured brown must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter L . The wire which is coloured green and yellow must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter  $\mathbf{E}$ 



If a 13 AMP (BS 1363) plug is used, a 3AMP Fuse must be fitted, or if any other type of plug is used a 13 AMP Fuse must be fitted, either in the Plug or Adaptor, or on the Distribution Board. **Note:** If a moulded plug is fitted and has to be removed take great care in disposing
